High School Internship

The High School Internship Program offers qualified Northern New Mexico high school seniors the opportunity to develop personally and gain work experience while receiving exposure to a variety of career fields. This popular program provides employment skills and assists local-area students with their school-to-work transition.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Completion of junior year prior to starting internships
- Cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher
- Must pass employment drug screening

Undergraduate Student Program

This year-round educational program provides students with relevant research experience while they pursue a bachelor's degree. This program is designed to complement student education with work experience related to courses through technical or professional placements.

Eligibility Requirements

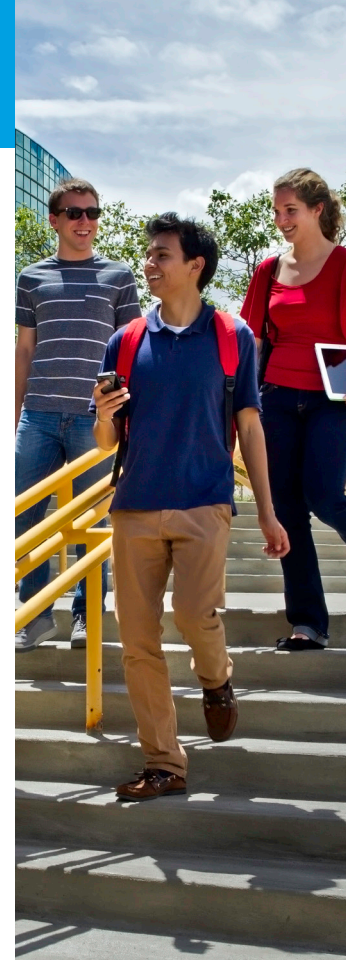
- Must be accepted to or enrolled in an undergraduate degree program
- Enroll in a minimum of 12 undergraduate credit hours per academic term
- Must have and maintain a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0/4.0 or better
- Must pass employment drug screening

Graduate Research Assistant Program

The Graduate Research Assistant (GRA) Program is a year-round educational program that provides students with relevant research and work experience while pursuing a graduate degree. Graduate opportunities are available in STEM as well as the professional and operation fields.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be accepted to or enrolled in a graduate degree program
- Enroll in a minimum of 6 graduate credit hours per academic term
- Must have and maintain a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.2/4.0 or better
- Must pass employment drug screening
